



British Champions launch RYA Offshore Racing Handbook

2005 Honda British Powerboat Champions Shelley Jory and Libby Keir, along with RYA Powerboat Racing Manager, John Puddifoot, launched the new comprehensive guide to powerboat racing, the *RYA Offshore Racing Handbook*, PB1, at the London Boat Show.

The RYA is the national authority for the sport in Great Britain, and the handbook covers all the general rules that govern powerboat racing as a whole, as well as the specific regulations that apply to certain classes and boats. The handbook also gives details on how to get started, how to protest and appeal, how races are organised and how to make record attempts. An extensive list of useful contacts, clubs and websites is also included.

Finalists for the 2005 Raymarine YJA Yachtsman of the Year Award, Shelley and Libby are the only all-girl Honda Formula 4-Stroke team. The girls are the reigning champions in a class traditionally dominated by men. It is the largest offshore powerboat series in the world. The girls recently took the 2005 title at the final round of this year's series at Guernsey in September.
