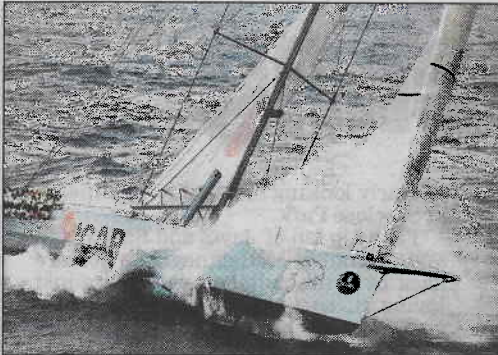

SOUTHAMPTON superyacht has crashed out of an attempt at the transatlantic speed record after hitting light airs.
